The annual National championships are on again! Please let us know if you intend to enter this year so we can support and encourage you!

Here's the full race listing for the event:

- الله National Penny Farthing Championship race (open). The fastest eight riders advance through heats in to the final, which is over 4 laps of the circuit, a total distance of one mile.
- Championship races for ladies, juniors (under 16), veterans 1 (50+), 2 (60+), 3 (70+).
- Slow race (last over the line wins)
- Slalom (two at a time around witches' hats)
- Novice race (first time riders)
- Sprint (200 metre dash)
- \bigcirc Relay (teams of 4, one lap each)
- Biathlon (run one lap, ride 2, run one)
- Miss 'n Out (last rider on each lap eliminated)
- Obstacle (run, carry bike, wheel bike, sprint)
- 🚯 Consolation (for those who haven't won a medal).
